Hayman's 1820 Facts

- Created by Christopher and James Hayman, direct descendants of James Burrough, who in 1820 founded Beefeater Gin
- A distinctive premium gin made from 100% pure grain spirit which together with a subtle blend of botanicals, is London distilled five times
- Hayman's 1820 is a gin that has been sweetened to create the world's first gin liqueur. It is based on Old Tom's Gin - the original lightly sweetened gin that was popular before the Second World War
- Hayman's 1820 allows the classic gin cocktails to be recreated as they are supposed to be

Tom Collins Cocktail



2 shots Hayman's 1820
2 dashes Angostura Bitters (optional)
1 shot Lemon Juice
Top up Soda Water

- Place Hayman's 1820 and lemon juice in an ice-filled high ball glass, then stir to mix. Add Angostura Bitters and top up with Soda water. Stir gently and garnish with a lemon slice

Classic Martini



1 shot Hayman's 1820
1 shot Vermouth

- Place the vermouth in shake with ice. Shake and strain away the excess. Add Hayman's 1820. Stir and strain into a pre-chilled cocktail glass. Add a twist of lemon and serve

Pink Gin



4 dashes Angostura Bitters
2 shots Hayman's 1820

- Coat a chilled highball glass with the Angostura bitters. Discard the excess, fill up with Hayman's 1820, and serve
